Curriculum

Midway UMC Preschool uses the Christian based Pinnacle Curriculum. It emphasizes being a Christian in our daily lives and is non-denominational.

Staff complete and execute age appropriate lesson plans each week, using the curriculum's monthly themes and Bible focus materials. Children will learn to make faith connections while participating in our daily activities.

Your child will be introduced to the alphabet, as well as letter and sound recognition, numbers, colors, calendar, weather, songs & rhyming, writing their names, grouping, patterns, sequencing and more.

Classroom discipline is learned by raising hands, taking turns, lining up, listening, sharing, cooperating and good manners.

Skill building is accomplished through circle time, show & tell, job helpers, arts & crafts, play centers, coloring, cutting, gluing, music & dance, books & story time, science, cooking, games, playground, field trips and more.

Our objective is to provide each child with the necessary cognitive skills he/she will need to be successful in kindergarten, provided they are emotionally and socially ready to start school.

Beyond the Curriculum

Daily:

All children will receive a snack & drink and we visit the playground or do large motor skill activities inside.

Weekly:

All children will attend Chapel, go to Enrichment & visit the Preschool Library; 3's & 4's will also have Tumbling and Music & Movement weekly.

We celebrate holidays and birthdays. We give you an opportunity to purchase fall, spring, class and graduation photographs.
